SILESIA STADIUM FACILITY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

hereinafter referred to as the *Terms and Conditions*, adopted under the Mass Event Safety Act of 20 March 2009 (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2017, item 1160, as amended) - under resolution no. 09/08/20017 of the Management Board of Stadion Śląski Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością with registered office in Katowice.

§ 1 - General Provisions

1. The *Terms and Conditions* apply in the area of the Silesian Stadium *Facility* in Chorzów, hereinafter referred to as the *Facility*.
2. The administrator of the Silesian Stadium *Facility* in Chorzów is Stadion Śląski Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością with registered office in Katowice, hereinafter referred to as the *Administrator*.
3. The *Facility Terms and Conditions* have been adopted to determine and specify the terms of proper use of the Silesian Stadium *Facility*, including devices, objects and rooms, by all persons present in its area, including: personnel, tenants, sportsmen, fans, guests and other third parties.
4. All persons entering the Stadium area are obliged to observe the provisions of the *Facility Terms and Conditions*, regardless of the obligation to observe other regulations, including agreements, event terms and conditions, etc.
5. The provisions of the *Facility Terms and Conditions* do not supersede or exclude the provisions of lease agreements for the rooms, areas and objects of the Stadium or other agreements on this matter but are their potential supplementation. All discrepancies arising from the above shall be settled under the provisions of the specific agreements.
6. The *Facility* opening hours are as follows: 07:00 am to 10:00 am.
7. Entering the *Facility* outside the hours set by the *Administrator* always requires a consent and shall follow the terms predetermined by the *Administrator*.
8. The Silesian Stadium is a multifunctional facility, holding sports, cultural, recreation and other events that can be organised in the *Facility*.
9. The Silesian Stadium *Facility* comprises:
 - a) Stadium - main arena;
 - b) complex of multifunctional rooms in the block of the eastern tribunes of the main arena;
 - c) training pitch with artificial turf, with athletics infrastructure;
 - d) training pitch with natural turf, with athletics throw zone;
 - e) other objects and facilities, including training infrastructure, located in the so-called "eastern foreground" of the Silesian Stadium;
 - f) car park.
10. Sports, recreation, cultural, commercial-service, office and gastronomic activities are conducted at the Silesian Stadium.
11. The commercial, gastronomic, service, cultural activities, including transmissions, radio and television broadcasts, filming, photo shoots can take place at the *Facility* only and exclusively subject to the *Administrator's* consent the award of which may be conditional upon consent of the event organiser.
12. The activities consisting in sale of products and services as well as advertising activity in the area

of the *Facility* are conducted by the *Administrator*.

13. The agreements concluded regarding use of the Silesian Stadium must be compliant with the commonly governing law.
14. All sports, cultural and recreation events are held according to the governing Polish law and regulations proper for the nature of the event, organisation and associations.
15. The *Facility* area is under video surveillance.
16. All devices and equipment of the Silesian Stadium must be used only for the purposes they were installed for and according to their intended application.
17. The *Facility Administrator* accepts no liability for objects lost or left in the area of the *Facility*.

§ 2 - Terms of Entry, Movement and Use of the Facility

1. The Silesian Stadium *Administrator* reserves the exclusive right to let persons in the area of the *Facility*, except for mass events.
2. Access control applies at the *Facility*.
3. In the *Facility* area, there are limited access zones that only persons holding proper identifiers/access cards can enter. The limited access zones include, without limitations: main arena, VIP lounges, control centre, technical rooms and office rooms.
4. In justified cases, the persons present in the *Facility* area are obliged to:
 - at the request of the Facility Security, other guards or information services of the *Administrator* or event organiser - present an identity document and undergo luggage control.
5. The *Administrator* reserves the right not to let in or to remove from the *Facility* area persons who refuse being searched by the security guards, information services or Police.
6. Youth up to 15 years of age can enter the *Facility* only under supervision of an adult.
7. The security guards are authorised to control persons, using technical means, to verify if they do not pose a threat due to consumption of alcohol, use of drugs or as a result of carrying weapons or dangerous objects.
8. Persons under the influence or whose behaviour indicates that they are intoxicated and pose a risk of danger will not be permitted to enter the Silesian Stadium *Facility* or will be removed if already in its area.
9. Pedestrian traffic runs through designated zones. It is prohibited to hinder or block access to such areas or to store there any objects.
10. It is prohibited to block pavements, passages, staircases or evacuation routes. It is prohibited to use the said areas for purposes other than moving around the *Facility*.
11. All persons present in the *Facility* area during a mass event are obliged to observe the *Facility Terms and Conditions* as well as the event terms and conditions subject to disciplinary and penal liability.
12. Vehicles can enter the *Facility* area through the gates indicated by the *Administrator*.
13. Moving around the *Facility* in vehicles shall be compliant with the guidelines of the *Administrator* and must follow the set traffic routes.
14. When in the *Facility* area, the vertical and horizontal signage of the passage routes must be observed.
15. It is prohibited to occupy, block or hinder in any manner access to the access roads,

evacuation routes, road zones intended for motor or pedestrian traffic. Parking is allowed only in places intended for this purpose.

16. All objects, including vehicles, goods and other things left unattended by any third parties in breach of the above provisions will be removed at the expense of their owners.

§ 3 - Safety

1. The terms of safety regarding times and methods of access to the Silesian Stadium, terms of motor and pedestrian traffic, bringing in hazardous objects established by the *Administrator* apply in the *Facility* area.
2. The *Facility* area is under video surveillance to ensure safety of all users.
3. The security services and video surveillance in the area of the Silesian Stadium is conducted by the entity providing person and property security services ("Facility Security") appointed by the *Administrator*.
4. The Facility Security employees are authorised and obliged to enforce the provisions of the *Facility Terms and Conditions* as well as other regulations and laws effective at the *Facility* to ensure safety of the Silesian Stadium users.
5. The Facility Security guards can, in particular:
 - a) request permission to carry out luggage or vehicle search;
 - b) request unauthorised persons or persons disturbing the order to leave the *Facility*;
 - c) request permission to verify the identity documents of persons to establish their identity and right to enter the *Facility*;
 - d) use means of physical coercion against persons posing a threat to human life or health, goods entrusted to the security services or to defend themselves against an attack until such persons are handed over to the Police.
6. The decision on *Facility* evacuation is made by the authorised representative of the Silesian Stadium *Administrator* or Facility Security Shift Manager in agreement with the *Administrator* based on assessment of the existing threats or by the authorities and services authorised under the law.
7. Detailed "Fire Safety Instructions" have been prepared for the *Facility* - all tenants and users of the Silesian Stadium are obliged to familiarise themselves with the said document.

§ 4 - Prohibitions

1. Hazardous materials:
 - a) it is prohibited to bring hazardous materials in the *Facility* area, including materials posing a fire hazard, a threat to health, with troublesome smell, flammable and materials prohibited under the law;
 - b) it is prohibited to bring in firearms and cold steel weapons, explosives and hazardous chemical substances in the *Facility* area;
 - c) the prohibition to bring in and carry weapons does not apply to entities authorised under the law.
2. The following cannot be brought in the *Facility* area:
 - a) any weapons and other dangerous objects;
 - b) pyrotechnical products and other products of similar effect and posing a fire hazard;
 - c) alcohol, intoxicating and psychotropic substances;
 - d) containers for gas spraying, caustic and colouring substances;
 - e) advertising materials, except as admitted under prior written consent of the *Administrator*;
 - f) bottles or glass and metal containers;
 - g) flag and banner poles;
 - h) noise generating devices with a mechanical drive;
 - i) balaclavas and other garment elements used for masking to prevent the Police and guards from identifying the person;
 - j) packages, suitcases, backpacks and any types of enclosed objects the control of which is difficult.
3. The following is prohibited in the *Facility* area:
 - a) climbing or going through devices not intended for public use, including but not limited to facades, fences, walls, pitch fencing, lighting devices, video camera platforms, all types of masts and roofs;
 - b) entering areas not intended for spectators: pitch, indoor rooms, utility rooms, technical rooms, catering rooms, security rooms, medical rooms, Police rooms and buffer sectors closed for fans;
 - c) throwing any objects;
 - d) using obscene or offence language, singing obscene songs or offending any persons;
 - e) starting fire, setting off fireworks, firecrackers and all types of flares;
 - f) selling any types of goods or tickets without permission and organising fundraising without the Stadium *Administrator's* consent;
 - g) hanging flags and banners with offensive, provocative or racist content on the fencing;
 - h) covering advertisements, information signs and direction signs;
 - i) destruction of property, objects, devices and equipment in the *Facility* area.

- j) bringing animals in the area of the main arena or other facilities, if the terms and conditions so stipulate, except for guide dogs and service animals.

§ 5 - Liability

1. Persons breaching the terms of order and safety of the *Facility* as well as breaching the *Facility Terms and Conditions* will be subject to disciplinary or penal liability according to the governing law.
2. The *Facility Administrator* and event organiser reserve the right to have the security guards or the Police remove from the *Facility* any person infringing the above rules and provisions of the *Facility Terms and Conditions* or whose presence at the *Facility* is or could, for various reasons, be interpreted as a source of threat for other persons.
3. Persons breaching the terms of safety and order at the *Facility* will be subject to penal and administrative liability.
4. The *Facility Administrator* reserves the right to seek compensation for any damage inflicted to the *Facility*, including damage to the *Administrator's* reputation or causing riots and participating in them.
5. Entering the *Facility* is equivalent to consent to observance of the *Facility Terms and Conditions* as well as other rules and regulations.
6. Accidents and damage must be reported to the *Facility Administrator* immediately through security guards or calling 500 006 415.

§ 6 - Amendment of Terms and Conditions

1. The Silesian Stadium *Administrator* reserves the right to amend the *Terms and Conditions* at any time.


§ 7 – Additional Provisions

 - a) Fire Safety Instructions;
 - b) VIP Lounge Terms and Conditions;
 - c) Silesian Stadium Tour Terms and Conditions;
 - d) Terms and Conditions of the artificial turf training pitch with athletics functions;
 - e) Terms and Conditions of the natural turf training pitch with athletics functions;
 - f) Terms and Conditions of multifunctional courts (basketball, volleyball, crossminton);
 - g) Terms and Conditions of tennis courts;
 - h) Terms and Conditions of multifunctional rooms;
 - i) Terms and Conditions of sports locker rooms.
